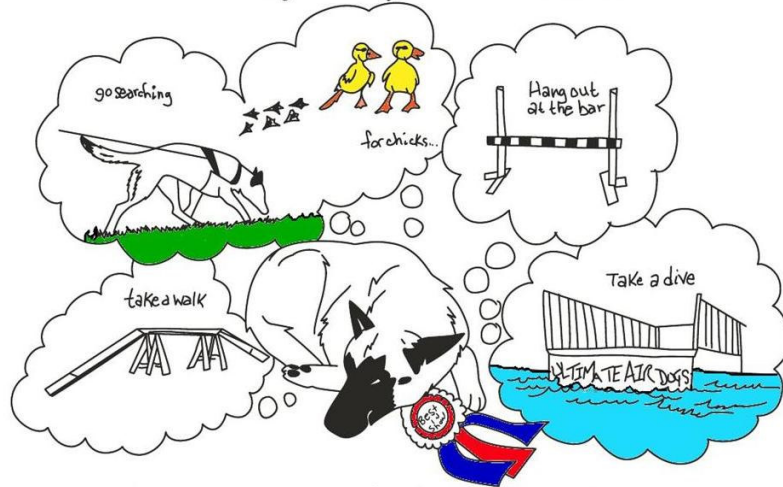

MOVE-UP REGULATIONS:

If a dog earns an AKC agility title before this event, it can be advanced to the next level of competition. However, written notice must be given to the Trial Secretary **no later than 6pm on Wednesday, April 4th**. Day to day move-ups will be accepted if received **before the close of the trial Wednesday, April 11th**. Trial close will be considered to be the awarding of ribbons for the last class on that day. Move-ups will be added to the end of the running order of the class they move up to and every effort will be made to accommodate handlers running multiple dogs in the same class.

SITE INFORMATION:

All classes will be held indoors on soccer turf. 2 rings, 90ft. x 120ft. Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the entire area clean. Anyone witnessed not picking up after their dogs on the trial grounds will be excused from the trial with no entry fees refunded.

CRATING:

Crates may be set up Tuesday, April 10 between 4:00 pm and 6:00 pm. The building opens at 6:00 am on Weds and Thurs for set up. Crates may be left overnight, however, ABMC, Purina Farms, and Bluestem Agility Trial Services, LLC will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site. Dogs may not be left overnight.

PLEASE NOTE: FLOOR COVERING WILL BE REQUIRED UNDERNEATH CRATES.
Crating will be on rubber mats and you will be responsible for any damage to the flooring.

FOOD: Food and beverages will be available at the show site.

CATALOGS:

Running order sheets will be available to all exhibitors at no charge. Full catalogs will be available for sale for \$12.00 on the day of the trial, but supplies will be limited. Advanced catalog sales recommended. Please indicate on your entry form if you would like a catalog. **National Specialty Catalogs, listing Malinois only, will be available at trials.**

PRIZES AND AWARDS:

Rosettes will be awarded to First through Fourth place in each class and height division. Flat ribbons will be awarded to those dogs receiving qualifying scores (A limited number of qualifying rosettes will be available). New title rosettes, and MACH, PACH & PAX rosettes and bars will also be awarded. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. Prizes must be claimed the day of the show-none will be mailed.

ALL PRIZES, IF NOT AWARDED IN THE RING, MUST BE PICKED UP DURING THE EVENT AT THE PURINA BOOTH. PRESENTATION OF THE WINNING RIBBON IS REQUIRED. PURINA RESERVES THE RIGHT TO MAKE PRIZE SUBSTITUTIONS OF EQUAL OR GREATER VALUE IN THE EVENT A SPECIFIC LISTED PRIZE IS NOT AVAILABLE.

JUMP HEIGHT DIVISIONS:

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division.

26 inch jump height may be entered at the owner's discretion.

HEIGHT CARD REQUIREMENT:

When filling out the entry form, please designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. *Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4.*

REFUNDS:

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. Entry fee for bitches that come into season will be refunded in full if Trial Secretary is notified 30 mins before the start of judging that day. Entry fee for a dog that is injured after the closing date will be refunded (less \$12 administrative fee per day) if Trial Secretary is notified 30 mins before the start of judging that day.

OBSTACLES & TIMERS:

Obstacles will meet the specifications in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. 24" weave poles will be used. Electronic timing will be used.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER:

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC, ILP or PAL number. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind or deaf dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form and the trial-giving club is offering the optional mixed breed classes. *These trials are open to dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program.*

RINGSIDE:

Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having the dog ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Please help your fellow competitors, the trial workers, and the judge by checking in with the gate steward well ahead of your turn, and being prompt at the line when your turn comes to run.

SAFETY AND BEHAVIOR:

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulation of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

LIABILITY:

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. ABMC, Purina Farms, nor Bluestem Agility Trial Services, LLC will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

Any complaints filed with show committee by the hotel will be brought before disciplinary committee. None of us want that.

MOST VERSATILE BELGIAN MALINOIS AWARD

(As voted on by membership January 2011)

Membership in the ABMC is not required. However, the dog being entered must be a Belgian Malinois.

A handler can enter a dog for the Most Versatile Award by filling out the MVBMA form available in the premium list or online at www.abmcspecialty.com. The form can then be mailed to the address listed on the form or turned in at least 1 hour prior to handler's 1st event at the specialty.

The MVBMA committee chairperson will track the results based on the Show/Trial Secretary results. Handlers are encouraged to report wins and/or qualifying scores to chairperson. Points for each dog entered will be posted daily.

The winner will be announced at the After Party on Sunday night. The winner of the award need not be present to win. If the winner is not present, awards will be mailed.

Qualifications for Most Versatile Belgian Malinois Award:

Dogs must participate and earn points in at least four of the following six venues:

- 1) Agility (Standard and JWW Regular or Preferred classes in Novice, Open or Excellent)
- 2) Conformation (Regular and Sweepstakes)
- 3) Obedience (Regular, Graduate Novice or Open, and Versatility classes only)
- 4) Rally (Regular classes only)
- 5) Herding
- 6) Tracking

A dog may be entered in more than four venues. The single highest point value earned in each venue will be used in tabulating the points earned for that venue. Example: Dog A wins the Excellent A Regular Standard Agility class (5 points) and Double Q's in Regular Standard and Regular JWW (7points). Dog A will be awarded 7 points not 12.

The dog with the highest combined total score for all venues will be awarded Most Versatile Belgian Malinois. In the event of a tie see "Tie Breaking Criteria" at the end of the points list.

Prizes:

Most Versatile Malinois will receive a rosette and prize with a value matching that of Best Of Breed.

Reserve Most Versatile Malinois will receive a rosette and prize with a value matching that of Best Of Opposite Sex.

All dogs that qualify in at least four venues will receive a rosette and a certificate honoring their achievement.

- 7 points: Double Q in Excellent A or B

Agility (Preferred Classes)

- 1 point: Qualifying score in Novice
- 2 points: Qualifying score in Open or winning Novice Class (A or B)
- 3 points: Qualifying score in Excellent (A or B) or winning Open Class
- 4 points: Winning Excellent Class (A or B)
- 5 points: Double Q in any combination of Standard and JWW classes at any two preferred levels
- 6 points: Double Q in Excellent A or B

Agility High Scoring Malinois in Trial and Combined High Scoring Malinois

- 7 points: High Scoring Malinois in Trial
- 8 points: Combined High Scoring Malinois

- 1 point: Place 1-4 in a class
- 2 points: Reserve Winners Dog or Bitch
- 3 points: Winners Dog/Winners Bitch

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.
