Day to day move-ups will be accepted if received **before the close of the trial Friday, June 13th or Saturday, June 14th, 2008**. Trial close will be considered to be the awarding of ribbons for the last class on that day. Move-ups will be added to the end of the running order of the class they move up to and every effort will be made to accommodate handlers running multiple dogs in the same class.

SITE INFORMATION:

All classes will be held in air conditioned building on stall matting. Ring size is 72ft. x 112ft. Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the entire area clean. Anyone witnessed not picking up after their dogs on the trial grounds will be excused from the trial with no entry fees refunded.

CRATING:

There will be very limited indoor crating available. There is ample room for tents outside, but limited shade. Please be prepared to stack crates indoors. X-pens and oversized chairs not allowed indoors. Crates may be left overnight, however, MAKC and Camp Bandy will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site. Dogs may not be left overnight. **No exhibitor set up before noon on Friday.**

FOOD:

The Wood County 4-H Club Dog Project will be selling food and beverages on site Saturday and Sunday to raise funds for their dog related activities.

CATALOGS:

Running order sheets will be available to all exhibitors at no charge. Full catalogs will be available for sale for \$7.00 on the day of the trial, but supplies will be limited. Advanced catalog sales \$5.00. Please indicate on your entry form if you would like a catalog.

PRIZES AND AWARDS:

Ribbons will be awarded to First through Fourth place in each class and height division. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to those dogs receiving qualifying scores. New title ribbons, Double Q ribbons, MACH ribbons & bars and PAX ribbons and bars will also be awarded. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. Prizes must be claimed the day of the show—none will be mailed.

JUMP HEIGHT DIVISIONS:

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division.

26 inch jump height may be entered at the owner's discretion.

HEIGHT CARD REQUIREMENT:

All exhibitors must produce an AKC JUMP HEIGHT CARD for each dog entered. A photocopy may be submitted with your entry (preferred) or presented to the Trial Secretary the morning of the trial. Any dogs without height cards MUST be measured, except for 24" or 26" class dogs (unless a VMO or Rep is present). If you run without first presenting a height card or obtaining on-site measurement, you will be disqualified.

REFUNDS:

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Entry fee for bitches that come into season or a dog that is injured after the closing date will be refunded (minus AKC, judge and administrative fee) if a veterinarian's certificate is presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial.

OBSTACLES:

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER:

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC ILP or PAL number, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Dogs of registerable breeds with an accepted foreign registration number are eligible to participate subject to Chapter 11, Section 1 of the Dog Show Rules. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

RINGSIDE:

Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having the dog ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Please help your fellow competitors, the trial workers, and the judge by checking in with the gate steward well ahead of your turn, and being prompt at the line when your turn comes to run.

SAFETY AND BEHAVIOR:

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulation of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

LIABILITY:

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Marshfield Area Kennel Club, and its members, agents, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

HOTEL INFORMATION:

From North, South and West: From I-39 in Stevens Point, take Hwy 10 East (towards Waupaca) to Lake Road/Amherst Junction Exit. Turn right onto Lake Road. Cross railroad tracks and continue on Lake Road after first stop sign (Lake Emily will be on your right). Turn left at second stop sign onto Lake Emily Rd. Camp Bandy is on the Left (approximately 5 blocks).

From East: Take Hwy.10 West just past Amherst to County Road B Exit. Turn right onto Cty Rd B. Almost immediately, turn left onto County Road Q. Approx 1 mile down, road makes a sharp turn to the left and becomes Main Street. Stay on Main St as it angles left and becomes Lake Emily Rd. Camp Bandy is on the Right just out of town (approximately 3 blocks).

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
